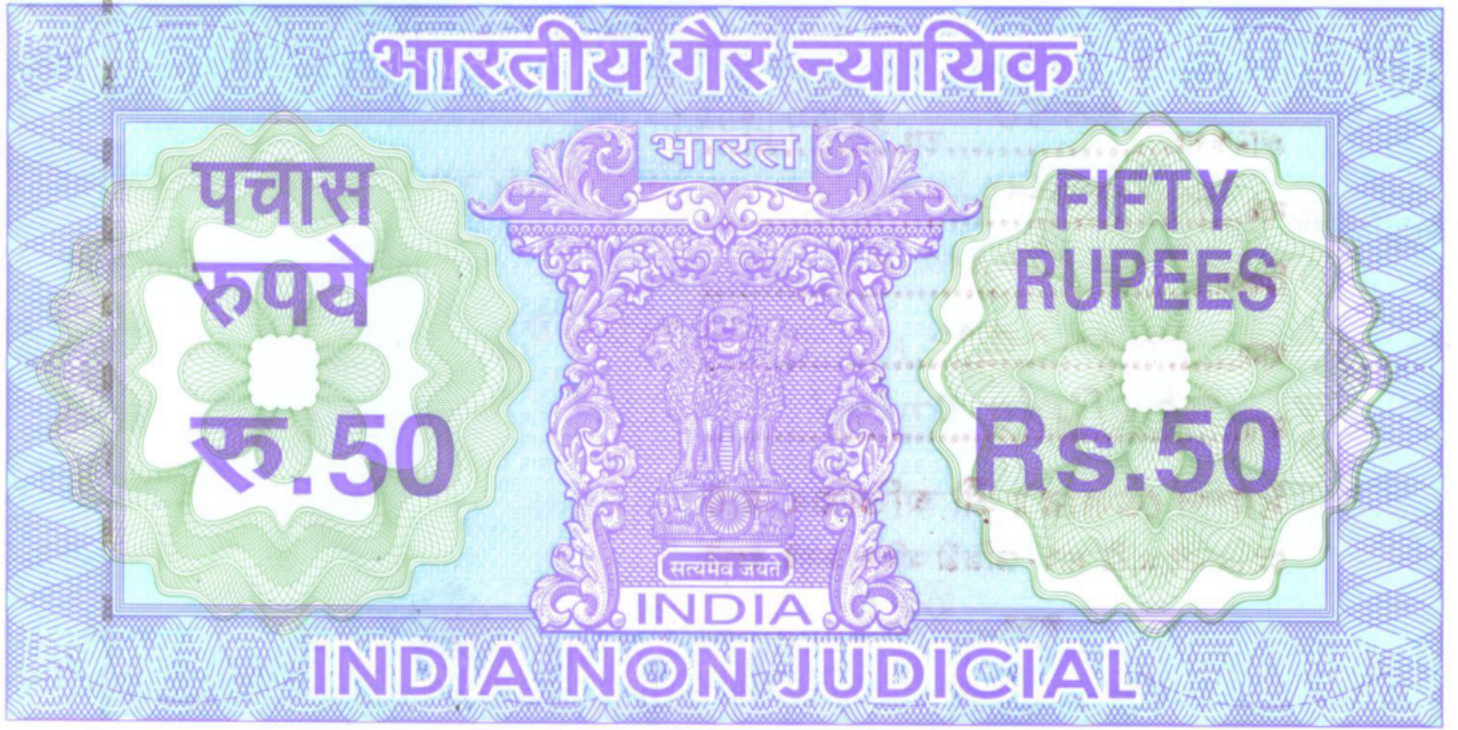

WHEREAS The Settlor, hereby conveys, transfers, and assigns to the Trustees the above referred sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand Rupees) only as corpus to the Trust, the receipt of which, the Trustees do hereby admit and acknowledge, The Settlor of the **TRUST** hereby conveys, transfers assigns to the **TRUSTEES** the aforesaid funds as mention in the schedule hereunder of the Not any immovable and or movable properties as of now and allows the trustees to have and to hold the same in trust as corpus or the trust, to be used by the trustee to carry out and fulfill the objects of the trust set forth here win and the settlor of the trust hereby relinquishes for all time any claim to or interest in the said assets or fund forming the subjects matter of the trusts.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Name of the trust shall be:-**PROGRESSIVE PLANNER FOUNDATION**

2. The Registered Head office of the Trust shall be located at Block No- O (508), 59, K. C. Ghosh Road, Baranagar (m), North 24 Parganas, West Bengal-700050, West Bengal, India;

3. The office of the Trust may be opened to any other place in West Bengal or to any other of India or open local office or offices at Places deemed necessary. **This place shall be used for corresponding address only and shall not be treated and used as Trust Property.** It may be noted that the above mentioned corresponding address is not the property of Government or any other Government Authority.

4. **INTERPRETATION:-**

- a) Trust means the Trust created by this Deed viz., **PROGRESSIVE PLANNER FOUNDATION, A non-profitable, non-commercial non political PUBLIC CHARITABLE PURPOSE ONLY**
- b) The Board shall mean the Board of the members which may be filled up by co-option of the existing Trustees created by this Deed with renowned and suitable persons.
- c) **TRUST PROPERTY:-**shall include every kind of property movable and immovable to be owned by the Trust and mentioned in accounts, books and other documents in the possession, custody and control or that ought to be in possession, custody and control or possession of the Trust.

5. **AIMS AND OBJECTS OF TRUST:-**

The objects for which the Trust established are:

1. To promote the educational, social and economic upliftment and general welfare of the people of the country specially for the people of West Bengal by
2. To support the development of children below 6 years with focus on Supplementary Nutrition, non formal preschool education and awareness and capacity building for mothers for nutritional and health needs of the child.
3. To empower adolescent girls (11-18 years) through nutrition, health care and life skill education.

4. To provide a safe and secure environment for overall development of children who are in need of care and protection and those in conflict with law.
5. To create awareness on the consequences of Child Marriage and to prevent child marriage in the state to remove the bias against girl children, to correct adverse sex ratio and eradicate social evils.
6. To prevent women and children from being abused and trafficked.
7. To enable Economic, Social and Political Empowerment of women by :
 - Capacity Building and Skill Enhancement
 - Access to Financial Resources
 - Market Access and Networking
 - Promoting Innovation and Technology Adoption
 - Policy Advocacy and Legal Support
 - Raising awareness about women's economic rights, opportunities, and the importance of gender equality
 - Advocating for increasing female labour force participation in formal sector
 - Improving women's income and employment
 - Addressing gender-based violence
 - Promoting gender mainstreaming and inclusivity
8. To provide services through Residential homes, Clinics, Day care education & training centres, Residential education & training centres and home based training programmes in different relevant areas of assessment, programme development and implementation to :-
 - a. Persons with Mental Illness
 - b. Street Children
 - c. Woman in need
 - d. Senior Citizen
2. To conduct long term and short term courses in the areas of :-
 - a. Special Education
 - b. Clinical Counseling and Rehabilitation Psychology
 - c. Physiotherapy
 - d. Vocational training and Employment
 - e. Community Based Rehabilitation
 - f. Disability Rehabilitation Management
3. To organize camps and awareness programmes in the areas of:-
 - a. Disability Rehabilitation
 - b. Mental health care and allied services
 - c. HIV-AIDS, TB, Cancer or any other health concerns
9. To conduct short term training programme in the areas of disability Rehabilitation, Mental health and allied services for parents / siblings of persons with special needs, professionals and personnel working in the related and allied fields.
10. To conduct training on
 - Prevention of ragging and Bullying in Educational Institutions
 - Prevention of Sexual Abuse of children
 - Child rights laws including prevention of child marriage, trafficking, child labor

- Counseling and behavior management
 - Life skills
 - CSR and Sustainability
 - **Environmental, social and governance (ESG) framework**
11. To conduct research in the areas of: -
 - a. Disability rehabilitation including Autism and cerebral palsy
 - b. Mental Health Care
 - c. Rehabilitation of street children, women in need and senior citizens.
 12. To provide information and documentation services in the areas of disability rehabilitation and allied services, through library services and publication etc.
 13. To advocate for fundamental rights including early intervention services, education management and rehabilitation of exceptional persons, street children, women in need, senior citizens and persons with mental illness.
 14. To acquire, establish, run, maintain or manage school, hospital / health clinic for the benefit of street children, women in need and senior citizens.
 15. To encourage and develop individual or collective enterprise aimed at economic and / or spiritual self-sufficiency by way of identification of such projects and the practical functioning of each of these.
 16. To procure funds for the society in the form of donation, subscription or otherwise and to accept gifts or property, whether or not subject to any special trusts or conditions in favour of any or all the objectives of the society.
 17. To raise or borrow funds for the Society in such manner as the Governing Body of the Society think fit and to invest money, not immediately required, upon such securities and in such manner as may, from time to time, be determined by the Governing Body.
 18. To take on lease, hire purchase or otherwise acquire land, properties, flats, gardens, fisheries etc. and to reclaim, develop, improve, promote, maintain, undertake or work either alone or in conjunction with other organization and to organize production, distribution and marketing for the benefit of the people in general.
 19. To acquire machineries, implements tools etc. for carrying out project work either by purchasing them outright or by mortgaging of any assets or properties of the Society as deemed suitable by the Managing Committee.
 20. To open Branch Centers and to accord recognition as branch Centers to Societies / Organizations formed under the name of in any part of world.
 21. To incorporate any institution, societies or association having similar objects as and to co-operate actively with persons activation such objects.
 22. To lend or grant money to such persons on such terms as may be deemed expenditure to attainment of the objectives of the Society.
 23. To do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be deemed incidental or conducive to the foregoing objectives. However, the income and properties of the society whatsoever derived or obtained shall be paid to or divided amongst any of its members by way of profits.
 24. To above activities will not be undertaken without any mission other than philanthropy and will no way be tantamount to running business activities by members of the society with their own profit motive.
 25. To establish and run educational institution with hostel facility for boys and girls separately and to support and grant aid or other financial assistance to Schools, welfare centers, Charitable Institute.

26. To establish & run Schools, Colleges, Charitable Institutions in India for the benefit of general public.
27. To establish & maintain Adult Education Centers especially in the rural areas and in slums for eradicating illiteracy and ignorance.
28. To takeover, establish, acquire, start, run, maintain or manage Nursery Schools, Primary and High Schools, Colleges, Libraries, Reading Rooms, Study Centers, Vocational Training Centers, Nursing and Midwifery Training Centers, Crafts Training and Production Centers for the promotion of education and vocational skill among the boys & girls in general and particularly for the minority communities and backward classes.
29. To establish & maintain Charitable Hospital & Diagnostic Centre for the benefit of general public.
30. To start, set up, take over, acquire, run, maintain or manage Agriculture and horticulture Training Centers and Firms, Fishery and Poultry Training Centers, Fruit's processing Training Center for the economic and social upliftment of the people.
31. To provide financial assistance for deserving students to go abroad for higher studies.
32. To teach and promote oriental languages like English, other foreign languages etc, and Computer Education.
33. The trust is being organized for the promotion of spiritual, physical, mental, educational development and upliftment of adults and children of all ages without any distinction of caste, creed or religion and in the interest of mankind in general.
34. To aid or establish, takeover or collaborate with any institution or school or association, for physical, mental, spiritual, educational development, uplift of intelligence or its development.
35. To propagate, impart and adopt any audio-visual methods for solving the problems of crime, drug abuses and help in the inculcation of such behavior as would bring happiness to the family of man or generally mankind without reservation of his status, caste and religion.
36. To establish any home, institution or society for religious workshop and knowledge or for the welfare, maintenance and development or orphans of any community or society.
37. To work towards disaster relief, support and resilience building for communities prone to natural calamities or other types
38. To work towards environment sustainability by working towards affordable availability of clean water and sanitation, affordable energy and green energy, health and housing for people living in any parts of India.
39. To establish any institution or society for the welfare of victims of natural calamities and/or to provide food and shelter to any needy person or persons from time to time.
40. To undertake the compilation, printing and publication of :
41. Simple prayers for daily prayers for spiritual and psychological uplift of people generally.
42. Simple booklets explaining the basic morals and values of human life and for moral upliftment.
43. Books suitable for moral and spiritual instruction to school-going children, sages and other renowned personalities.
44. To award prizes in competition of physical games and educational competitions and toward scholarships for the needy and to provide ways and

means for the uplift of poor and needy children or individuals and to inculcate moral discipline.

45. To establish employment, vocational and carrier bureau and to run audiovisual units for the propagation of basic principles and advancement of human knowledge and for creating awareness about Human Rights.
46. To arrange and provide such medical aid and such other assistance necessary for living to the needy persons who are otherwise incapable or handicapped or mentally or physically retarded and financially uplift any person of poor class.
47. To render any social, moral and financial assistance for betterment of life of any unmarried girl or boy, widow or widower from time to time.
48. To accept donations, raise subscription, from the members of the trust or other persons, to invest the funds of the trust with such individuals, societies, firms or companies, for providing income to the trust, on such terms and conditions as may deem proper and necessary for the fulfillment of the aims and object of the trust and to further its interest as enumerated above.
49. To provide for all activities for improving the moral standards of the people promoting respect for all religions of tolerance and cordial feelings between man and woman irrespective of difference of caste, colour, creed or religion.
50. To promote spiritual studies and open spiritual training and Yoga centers for general public and to do everything to make spiritual studies popular amongst the public.
51. To start, maintain and assist in relief measures in those parts which are or become subjected to natural calamities like famine, fire, flood, earthquakes etc.
52. To establish, found and maintain the libraries, reading rooms for the use and convenience of general public.
53. To award prizes, medals and that like in universities, colleges, schools etc, to encourage students for higher and better education.
54. To give monetary help to disabled or blind persons in the form of monthly allowance or gratuities.
55. To open, found, establish, maintain and assist leper asylums or other institutions for helping the poor, destitute, widows and orphans of all faiths and communities.
56. To give stipends, allowances or gratuities, recurring or otherwise, for the maintenance etc., for such time or duration as may be deem proper and necessary.
57. To do any other act or thing which is ancillary to the achievement of any of the above stated object.
58. To perform that notwithstanding anything herein contained in the income as also the surplus of the trust fund the same shall be applicable and applied to for public charitable purposes only within such territories and subject to such conditions or limitations if any as may from time to time be laid down by the income tax act, 1961 or any other act or acts governing taxation of income and wealth public charitable trusts so as to render the trust hereby established as well as its income eligible for exemption from taxation under such act or acts now prevailing or any modification, replacement or re-enactment thereof.
59. To run programs for tribal welfare:
 - a. Working for welfare of STs
 - b. Strengthening Education among ST Girls in Low Literacy Districts

- c. Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)
 - d. To promote and Establish Tribal Research Institutes
 - e. Institutional Support for Development and Marketing of Tribal Products/Produce
 - f. Research Information & Mass Education, Tribal Festival and Other Social Activities
60. To act in such a way that the Trust hereby established shall always retain the status of the one to which the provision 80G and section 35 CCA of the income tax act, 1961 or any modification, replacement or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation or contribution thereto is eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hand of the donor.
61. To co-operation with national, international organization, having similar objectives and reputes or receive representative from such organization.
62. To create job opportunities for local / zonal / and other people by establishing S.S.I. Unit / Handicraft Unit / Medical sub -unit / home industries for the development and upgrading economy of the unemployed youth of both sexes, handicapped, orphans and other categories of people, knitting tailoring etc , and to organizing training programmes for such developmental programmes.
63. The organization may take loan from banks / FI / DFI etc. for the project from time to time as under: -
- a. Renewable Energy projects lime solar wind bio-mass/bio-gas/Horticulture/Floriculture/Vermi-culture/Sericulture, and all types of agriculture project etc. in any parts of India
 - b. To take up any water-shed management project in the adjoining area,
 - c. Rain water harvesting project both in urban and rural set up to save water
 - d. Maintenance of nursery for indoor plants, landscaping, fisheries, animal husbandry, diary and sericulture training and production for rural women and youth population
 - e. To support create infrastructures for drinking water, sanitation and hygiene practices for rural and urban slums population and schools
 - f. To establish the training centre on youth Development, Sports Engagement and Physical Activity, Demonstration Projects, and Tourism resorts, Hotels, Homestays in various parts of India.
 - g. Family planning as well as socio-development option can also be taken as deemed fit to help the rural population in the succeeding years to come.
 - h. To use the profits of surplus income for the developmental activities but shall not be distributed among the Trustees
 - i. To propagate the idea of integrated Social Development in all possible manner,
 - j. Family planning as well as socio-development option can also be taken as deemed fit to help the rural population in the succeeding years to come.
 - k. To use the profits of surplus income for the developmental activities but shall not be distributed among the Trustees.
- l. To render help, arrange for and encourage and promote celebrations of national, cultural, social and such other festivals and Jayanties as conducive of this object.
- m. Provided, however, that any contributions by the trusties to or co-operation with any other trust, society or project having as its sole objects all

or any of the aforesaid objects shall mean furtherance of the objects of this TRUST.

- i. **This Trust shall be commenced on and from 02/05/2025**
 - ii. **The Settlor and Trustee not the owner of the Trust property they are only custodian of the property they cannot claim any property as his/their own property**
 - iii. **The trust shall never borrow and/or augment money from the public or open market by announcing attractive financial investment scheme.**
 - iv. **All aims /objects/purpose of the trust herein stated above shall come into effect/force after necessary appointment of the competent govt. authority in the case where affiliation / permission/license/ sanction is required.**
 - v. **The trust will never acts like Micro financing, micro credit, franchise and Money Laundering (act-2012) Economic offence/crime and in nature and shall not obtain any donation or like that from abroad without getting the permission of FCRA ACT from the central Govt./the competent Govt. authority which the Trust and the trustees are responsible for and the whole trust is void. And come under the all punishable laws.**
 - vi. **The Trust will never acts which are illegal and unlawful in nature and also oppose to the public policy and contrary to the law of the country for which the trust and the trustees are responsible for that and the whole trust is void and come under the all-punishable law.**
 - vii. **Lawful purpose: - A Trust may be created for any lawful purpose. The purpose of a Trust is lawful unless it is (a) forbidden by law, or (b) is of such a nature that, if permitted, it would defeat the provisions of any law, or (c) is fraudulent, or (d) involves or implies injury to the person or property of another or (e) the Court regards it as immoral or opposed to public policy. Every Trust of which the purpose is unlawful is void. And where a Trust is created for two purposes, or which one is lawful and the other unlawful, and the two purposes cannot be separated, the whole Trust is void.**
6. To perform that notwithstanding herein contained in the income as the corpus OF THE TRUST fund the same shall be applicable and applied to for PUBLIC CHARITABLE PURPOSE ONLY within such territories and subject to such conditions or limitation if any as may from time to time be laid down by the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any other acts governing taxation of income the wealth of PUBLIC CHARITABLE TRUST so as to render the TRUST hereby established as well as its income eligible for exemption from taxation under such Act or acts, now or prevailing or any modification replacement thereof.
 7. To act in such a way that the TRUST hereby established shall always retain the status of one such TRUST to which provisions of section 80G/ 12A/ 35AC/FCRA 10(23C)IV/V/VIA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification replacement or thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation or contribution thereto is recognized as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor.
 8. **ADMINISTRATION:-** The properties and funds shall vest in the name of Trustees constituted by persons executing the Deed of the Trust. The number of members of Board of Trustees shall not exceed 15 and the vacancies can be filled by co-option by the existing Trustees.

9. OFFICE BEARERS:-

Office bearers of the trust shall be initially as follows:-

The Board of Trustees is also Empowered to created any office bearer post and elect office bearers to fill up the post form the Trustees and/or from outside the Board of Trustees. The above office-bearers shall be elected by the co-option of the Trustee at a meeting convened for the purpose.

10. VACANCIES:-

A vacancy shall arise among the Trustees in the following cases-

- i. When a Trustee dies.
- ii. When he resigns his office as a Trustee.
- iii. If he becomes Bankrupt.
- iv. If he becomes in sane or otherwise become incapable to act or.
- v. When he is absent from three consecutive meeting of the Board, unless the Board records condoning such absence in the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees for substantial cause.
- vi. When it becomes insolvent.
- vii. When convicted of any criminal offence involving moral Turpitude.
- viii. When he acts or does anything detrimental to the interest of the Trust.
- ix. On medical evidence when he is declared physically or mentally unfit by a resolution of the Board at a meeting convened for the purpose.

11. FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

PRESIDENT:-

- i. To preside over the meeting of the Board of Trustee
- ii. To provide guidance, consultancy and advice of foster the activities of the Trust.
- iii. To exercise such other powers as the Board of Trustee may prescribe.

SECRETARY:-

- i. The Secretary shall be the Executive officer of the Trust and shall be in charge of the office and the work of the Trust.
- ii. Her responsibilities will be:
 - a) To convene meeting of the Board of Trustee in consultation with the President.
 - b) To maintain records & proceedings of the Board of Trustee.
 - c) To place all necessary and relevant records, papers and documents at the meeting of the Board of Trustee.
 - d) To communicate all decisions of the Board of Trustee or the President, appropriate persons or authorities.
 - e) To perform all such duties and all such directions ad may be given to her by the Board of Trustee.
 - f) She shall have full power to carry out day to day administrative work of the Trust, in particular she shall.
 - g) Appoint, promote and punish staff with approval of the Board.
 - h) Execute all policies, plans, programs of work initiated, laid down or approved by the Board.
 - i) Direct, supervise and control all activities of the Board and do all other acts which are necessary for effective implementation of the Trust's programmed of work.
 - j) Deal with cash, account record and documents of the Trust.

22. **THAT** the **TRUSTEES** shall reimburse and pay and discharge out of the **TRUST FUND** all expenses incurred in course of the execution and administration of the **TRUSTEES** and in uses or for carrying out their duties these presents but they shall not be entitled to any honorarium or salary for the **TRUST**:
23. **THAT** in case of difference of opinion among the **TRUSTEES** decision of the majority **TRUSTEE** as the case may be shall prevail and by every three months meeting of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** shall be held and evolution of the works of each member of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** shall be made in the annual meeting of the **BOARD** and in that meeting ineffective member of the **BOARD** shall be expelled in proper system:
24. **THAT** any **TRUSTEE** may delegate in writing all or any of his or her powers under these presents to his or her **CO-TRUSTEE** as nominee who will be entitled to exercise such power or powers. In the same manner as the **TRUSTEE** himself could do personally notwithstanding anything herein contained the **TRUSTEE** shall be entitled to use the name of the **TRUST** in connection with any matter relating to the said **TRUST** and for the purposes the said **MANAGING TRUSTEE** for the **TRUST** shall appoint, dismiss and reappoint any staff, manager, lawyer, adviser, advocate, auditor and substitutes and pay their expenses and fees as shall be deemed reasonable from time to time and for the purposes of the said matters and actions in Courts or otherwise the **TRUSTEES** or any of them or the **MANAGING TRUSTEE** shall be entitled to sign and verify all complaints, petitions, pleadings, written statements memorandums, Vakalatnamas powers the **TRUSTEES** or any of them shall be entitled to appear for and on behalf of the **TRUST** and give evidence orally or adduce any evidence and take necessary proceedings on the matters and actions:

28. **DELEGATION OF POWER :** The Trustee shall have the power to delegate the administration of the Trust to any third party which he in his absolute discretion shall see fit provided always that the Trustee remains responsible for the actions of any party to whom he has delegated authority.
29. **THAT** on a new **TRUSTEE** being appointed/nominated on his signing the Minute Book to holding the effect of his possession of the **TRUST PROPERTIES** shall vest in him along with the other **TRUSTEES** for the time being and he will be entitled or to carry out the duties and function of a **TRUSTEE:**
30. **THAT** for amendment or change of any clause of this **TRUST DEED** the **MANAGING TRUSTEE** shall prepare it and get in accepted by the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE: THAT** in case members of **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** decide finally in the meeting of the **BOARD OF TRUSTEE** that they shall not continue the **TRUST** may more, they shall after clearing all the accounted liabilities fully of the **TRUST** from the proceeds of the assets of the **TRUST**, wind up **THE TRUST** legally, and shall handover all the residue assets of the **TRUST** to a similar **CHARITABLE TRUST** or The Government who will carry on all the works of this **TRUST**.
31. **THAT** in all meetings of the **TRUSTEES** 3/4th of the existing **TRUSTEES** will form a quorum provided however, that if it the number of **TRUSTEES** falls below 3/4th then for the purpose of appointing a **TRUSTEE** 3/4 of the existing **TRUSTEE** will be a quorum.

32. IMMOVABLE PROPERTIES OF THE TRUST

No immovable property belongs to the Trust shall be sold, exchanged, transferred, converted, mortgaged or alienated in any manner whatsoever except when such exchange, transfer, conversion or alienation :

- i) Is imperative in the interest of the Trust and Institutions and Department connected therewith,
- ii) Is not likely to adversely affect to any extent whatsoever the existence and benefit of the Trust, Institution and departments connected therewith an object of the Trust, and
- iii) Is decided to that effect by the Board in its meeting by a resolution passed by majority of the Trustees present.

33. AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEME

If any time it is found that alterations in any of the provision of the Trust or scheme for the purpose of effective achievement of the object of the Trust are imperative and very essential, then the Board shall approve such alteration by a resolution passed in its meeting and thereafter the modification shall become part and parcel of the terms, condition and provisions of this Trust and of this scheme.

The Board may at any time and from time to time make, amend, delete and rescind rules and bylaws for the conduct of this business, for the control, management and administration of the Trust made under this Trust deed and for carrying out the objects of the Trust relating to any matter under this scheme,

provided that such rules and bylaws shall not be inconsistent with or repugnant to any provisions of the scheme of the Trust.

34. INVESTMENT OF TRUST FUNDS:

1. The Board of Trustees shall have the power to invest the funds, assets and properties of the Trust at their discretion in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 & circular of SEBI
2. The Board shall also determine from time to time, the amount it shall spend on the various activities of the Trust.

35. INDEMNITY:

The Board of Trustees shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

36. APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT:

The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

37. DISSOLUTION CLAUSE:

In the event of dissolution of the Trust, the entire Trust funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the Trust. The assets left if any, shall be disbursed to other Trusts or Associations having similar objectives after obtaining previous approval of Commissioner of Income Tax and in no event it shall be distributed in any manner, to any of the Board of Trustee or their relatives or related concerns.

38. AREA OF OPERATION:

That all activities of the Trust shall be extended to the territories of India.

39. IRREVOCABLE: That the Trust is irrevocable.

40. UTILISATION:

To apply the whole or part of the income of the Trust or accumulation thereof or whole part of the corpus of the Trust Fund for one or more of the object of the Trust may determine from time to time.

41. SAVE CUSTODY OF TRUST ESTATE:

That all securities, investments bonds, title deeds etc. relating to the Trust estate shall be kept in the safe custody with the Trustees or Bankers(s) of the Trust.

42. DECLARATION:

This Trust and Scheme set forth under Indenture shall come into force immediately after the execution and registration thereof. The Settlor and Trustees above named also hereby declare that they have consented to be the Trustee under this Trust and that in witnesses whereof the Settlor, Trustees above named as party hereto have affixed their signature hereunder.

SCHEDULE

At present the trust has no movable/immovable and landed property in it's own name and no movable/immovable and landed property is being settled in favour of this trust by this document and no immovable property is involved in this trust deed, except Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only).
